Poster — Canadian Army Recruitment

The army was constantly looking for recruits. Posters like this urged men and women who met age and health standards to enlist.

The text and imagery imply that eligible Canadians should be in military service, and that only those who have been discharged or who have unsuccessfully applied to enlist have valid reasons for not being in uniform.
