Poster – Mesdames s'en vont en guerre (We're in the army now)

This poster urged women to conserve household materials for the war effort.

Scrap items made from material such as metal, paper, fabric, glass and rubber were salvaged for war purposes. Even leftover cooking fat and bones were saved, as they could be used in making munitions or adhesives.
